JANUARY 27 SPEAKER: TOM WOLFE TOPIC: "Florida Native Bromeliads You Should Know"

This month's program will be a hands-on PowerPoint in-depth discussion on the native bromeliads that are found throughout the State of Florida. There are ten bromeliad species and two natural hybrids. All Florida growers should be knowledgeable about the state's natives.

Our meetings are open to the public and please invite your friends neighbors and relatives. They will receive a free newsletter for three months after their first visit and we hope they will join within that time period.

Tom Wolfe was born and raised in Wilkes-Barre, Pennsylvania and attended St. Pete Jr. College and Penn State. In 1955 he joined the U. S. Air Force and came to MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa. He served as an MP in Okinawa and North Africa. After service, he became a deputy sheriff in Hillsborough County and later worked as a chemist for the Jim Walter Research Corporation.

While looking for landscaping plants for his new home in 1964, he took an interest in bromeliads and to this day that interest has never wavered. Right away, he met members of the Bromeliad Guild of Tampa Bay and joined the Guild which was meeting in members' homes so he could learn more about bromeliads.

He became President of the Guild in 1969 and after serving twelve terms, he quit counting and he has been elected again as the 2020 President of the Guild. Tom became a BSI Accredited Judge in 1982 and is now a BSI Master Judge. He has enjoyed judging shows throughout the United States making and renewing friendships along the way. He has served on the FCBS as a representative and Officer for many years and his wife, Carol has served as the editor of the FCBS Newsletter for the last five years.

He was Chairman of the successful 1992 World Bromeliad Conference with 570 people in attendance. Tom served on the BSI Board from 1991 to 2005. Six of those years, he served as President of the BSI. He and his wife, Carol, were made Lifetime Members of the BGTB in 2004 for their years of tireless work with the Guild. Carol served two terms as President and eight years as Newsletter editor as well as many other positions with the Guild.

Tom believes in the importance of the local bromeliad society. He said, "The local club is the beginning point for introduction to bromeliads and is vital to the future of bromeliads. It is in the local club that interest in growing bromeliads is nourished, information is disseminated, bromeliads shows are sponsored, and the enthusiasm for bromeliads is encouraged through monthly meetings."

Tom's interest in the use of bromeliads in landscaping eventually led him to change careers and develop a business specializing in landscaping with an emphasis on bromeliads. He is well known in the Tampa Bay area for beautiful landscaping and specialty landscaped bromeliad beds. He has 10,000 square feet in greenhouses and 2.5 acres in Lutz, Florida for growing bromeliads indoors and outdoors.

Tom has developed many programs on bromeliads using a combination of live plants and power point programs giving excellent talks to garden clubs, plant societies and bromeliad societies in Florida and beyond. He has been promoting bromeliads for over fifty years through bromeliad organizations: Bromeliad Guild of Tampa Bay (BGTB), the Florida Council of Bromeliad Societies (FCBS) and the Bromeliad Society International (BSI) and he hopes that the work, effort, and the investment of time and energy will make a difference in future generations being able to enjoy bromeliads.
