#### Ray Lemieux will be speaking on Hybridizer and Authority on Terrestrial Bromeliads Tropiflora Nursery Sarasota, Florida

"How to grow, propagate and hybridize terrestrial bromeliads."

Ray has been employed by Tropiflora Nursery in Sarasota, Florida for the past 13 years. His primary responsibility is working with the terrestrial type bromeliads including Dyckia, Hechtia, Puya, Ananas, Deuterocohnia, Cryptanthus and Orthophytum. Ray has more experience working with terrestrials than anyone else in the United States.

In the process of propagating from seed as well as vegetative propagating, Ray has made several hybrids some of which are now in production.

Ray has been very involved in the Sarasota Bromeliad Society for many years and has served as President, Show Co-Chairman, and held many other positions. At one time, he and his wife cooked and served complete meals at their monthly meeting. Of course, attendance at the Sarasota Society was at an all time high with their delicious meals.

He has been a speaker at many bromeliad societies and other horticultural groups. It is good to be able to call upon a known expert in this area to give us a program.
