Ray LeMieux of Tropiflora Nursery in Sarasota will give a presentation titled *Bromeliad Basics 101*. According to his biographical sketch on the Tropiflora website, Ray is Tropiflora's long-time succulent grower, and is most knowledgeable about terrestrial bromeliads and succulent plants. He has been a plant collector for more than 15 years, and has traveled to Mexico, Venezuela, Madagascar and Singapore for the nursery to help collect and build a world-class succulent collection there. He is currently a member of the Central Florida Cactus & Succulent Society, the Bromeliad Society International, the Sarasota Bromeliad Society, and the Cactus & Succulent Society of America. Ray is a hands-on speaker and will have a lot of practical things to show and tell us regarding how we grow bromeliads.

Member Service Recognition Award

At the December meeting President Susan Sousa announced the recipient of this year's FWCBS Service Recognition Award: Harry Luther (1952-2012; pictured on far right). There is much to be said about Harry and why he is so deserved of this award, and we have asked Dennis Cathcart, his longtime friend and colleague, to offer a tribute to Harry at a not-too-distant meeting and tell us from his firsthand perspective what Harry meant to the bromeliad world. In the meantime the following is an all-too-brief summary about Harry's contributions to the world of bromeliads.



Harry was a native of St. Petersburg and longtime member of the FWCBS, which he joined as a teenager. Over the years he became a self-taught expert on bromeliads and went on to spend 32 years with the Marie Selby Botanical Gardens in Sarasota. There he served as the director of the (now former) Bromeliad Identification Center and Curator of Living Collections. During his time at Selby he created the largest living collection of bromeliads in the world, and maintained taxonomic files for more than 3,000 species and more than 2,000 photographic slides of living material. At the time of his passing in 2012 he was living in the Republic of Singapore where he held the position of Assistant Director of Horticulture at the Singapore Gardens by the Bay, National Parks Board. He was recognized internationally as an expert in the horticulture and botany of bromeliads and as one the leading experts on the bromeliad family. He had described over 100 new species, had several bromeliads named after him, wrote and published more than 200 journal articles, was a major contributor to many books and editorial advisor to a number of journals, and gave of his time tirelessly to those in need of assistance..
