
We still have face shields if you would like one. They are \$1.50 and please bring the correct amount of money. No change will be available.

Speakers

John Boardman and Pam Marion will be the speakers and will be talking about how to prepare your bromeliads for the Mother's Day Show. If you're a new member and have no idea what I'm talking about you sure will. John and Pam put on a fun program. John will be bringing broms to sell.





John Boardman started collecting bromeliads in 1982 after winning several bromeliads on a public television auction. He joined the Bromeliad Society of Central FL in 1990 and became active in showing bromeliads. Over the years John has served as Pres & VP.

At the 2002 World Bromeliad Conference in Saint Petersburg FL, he won Best Neoregelia with a mounted multiple of Neoregelia 'Ronald'. Years later he became an accredited Bromeliad Society International Master Judge.

John's favorite genus is Neoregelia for the amazing colors and patterns on the foliage. He grows bromeliads in Saint Cloud FL under a 35' x 30' greenhouse, also growing many different genera, but his favorite is growing variegated Neoregelias.

Pam joined the Bromeliad Society of Central FL in 1996.

Pam has held the following positions in the society: Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor and participated as a judges clerk at Mother's Day Bromeliad Shows.

She enjoys growing Tillandsias, Neoregilias, Vrieseas, Guzmanias and Cryptanthus as indoor and outdoor plants. Entering her first bromeliad show with Tillandsia fasciculata mounted on wood, she won Best Novice Division.
