Alton Lee, a 30-year member of our society, will give a talk on *Growing Bromeliads and Other Plants Inside*. He will add a brief, but timely, piece titled *Our Winter from Hell*, in which he will discuss cold damage problems and solutions for now and the future. Members are encouraged to bring in their wounded and dying (bromeliads) for evaluation.

MARCH MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Program

Ray LeMieux, with TropiFlora Nursery in Sarasota, talked about terrestrial bromeliads Deuterocohnia, Dykia, Encholirium, Hechtia, Orthophytum, Pitcarnia, and Puya. He provided both general and specific horticultural information on the various species, hybrids, and bi-generics he showed us (see photo below). A very few of the many points he made were:

- They prefer to grow in soil and in the sun.
- Grow them hard so they are hardier in the winter, with less tender parts to burn.
- Dyckia prefer more water than Hechtia.
- Encholirium, Hechtia, and Orthophytum are cold tender.
- Deuterocohnia and Dyckia are more cold hardy.
- Reduce watering when plant is blooming.
