Tom Wolfe will give a presentation titled *Roberto Burle Marx and Longwood Gardens*. Tom and his wife Carol live in Lutz and grow bromeliads on their 2.5 acres of land and greenhouses. Tom has been involved with bromeliads for over 45 years, and has been a member of the Bromeliad Guild of Tampa Bay since 1965. The subject of his talk, Burle Marx, is internationally known as one of the most important landscape architects of the 20th century. A modern nature artist and public urban space designer, he is credited with introducing modernist landscape architecture to Brazil. He was also a painter, print maker, ecologist, naturalist, artist and musician. Tom will show us Burle Marx's connection with bromeliads.
